FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

* **TITLE I - DIGNITY**

- * Art. 1 : Human dignity : Human dignity is inviolable. It must be respected and protected
- * Art. 3 : Right to the integrity of the person: Everyone has the right to respect for his or her physical and mental integrity
- * Art. 5 : Prohibition of slavery and forced labour : 2. No one shall be required to perform forced or compulsory labour

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

* **TITLE II - FREEDOMS**

- * Art. 6 : Right to liberty and security : Everyone has the right to liberty and security of person
- * Art. 7 : Respect for private and family life : Everyone has the right to respect for his or her private and family life, home and communications
- * Art. 8 : Protection of personal data : Everyone has the right to the protection of personal data concerning him or her

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

- * Art. 13 : Freedom of the arts and sciences : The arts and scientific research shall be free of constraint. Academic freedom shall be respected
- * Art. 14 : Everyone has the right to education and to have access to vocational and continuing training
- * Art. 15 : Freedom to choose an occupation and right to engage in work : 1. Everyone has the right to engage in work and to pursue a freely chosen or accepted occupation 2. Every citizen of the EU has the freedom to seek employment, to work, to exercise the right of establishment and to provide services in any Member State

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

- * Art. 16 : Freedom to conduct a business : The freedom to conduct a business in accordance with Union law and national laws and practices is recognised
- * Art. 17 : Right to property : 2. Intellectual property shall be protected

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

* **TITLE IV – SOLIDARITY**

- * Art. 27 : Workers' right to information and consultation within the undertaking : in good time
- * Art. 28 : Right of collective bargaining and action : the right to negotiate and conclude collective agreements at the appropriate level
- * Art. 30 : right to protection in the event of unjustified dismissal

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

- * Art. 31 : Fair and just working conditions : 1. Every worker has the right to working conditions which respect his or her health, safety and dignity. 2. Every worker has the right to limitation of maximum working hours, to daily and weekly rest periods and to an annual period of paid leave
- * Art. 35 : Health care : A high level of human health protection shall be ensured in the definition and implementation of all the Union's policies and activities

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

* **TITLE V- CITIZENS' RIGHTS**

- * Art. 41 – Right to good administration : the right to have his/her affairs handled impartially, fairly and within a reasonable time.
- * a) – the right to be heard, before any individual measure which would affect him/her adversely is taken
- * b) - the right to have access to his/her file
- * c) – the obligation of the administration to give reasons for its decisions

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

- * Art. 42 – Right of access to documents
- * Art. 43 – European Ombudsman
- * Art. 44 – Right to petition
- * Art. 45 – Freedom of movement and of residence

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS EU

* **TITLE VI – JUSTICE**

- * Art. 47 – Right to an effective remedy and to a fair trial. Public hearing within a reasonable time by an independent and impartial tribunal. Right of being advised, defended and represented. Availability of legal aid.
- * Art. 48 – presumption of innocence and right of defense
