On behalf of the Swiss Medical Association, we are pleased to invite you all to Gibraltar on the **27-28th of May 2011**, for the spring meeting of the E.A.N.A.


We hope very much that you will enjoy traveling to Gibraltar, either through Malaga or directly. A bus service will be organized from Malaga (£30/person) to drive you to the Rock Hotel in Gibraltar. In case you could not use it for some reason, the timetable of public buses shall be communicated – but this means that you will first have to catch a bus at the airport to the main bus station in Malaga, and then take a bus for La Linea, the border Spanish town with Gibraltar. There are only about five such buses a day and the whole travel time shall take you about three hours (because of many stops). Nevertheless, we do hope very much that you will manage to make it to the welcome dinner at the Rock Hotel on the 26th of May at 8 pm.

Our official dinner on Friday evening will take place at the Mons Calpe, at the summit of the Rock, which we shall reach by cable car. From there, we shall not only have a gorgeous view around, but also enjoy a good and friendly meal. A round trip of Gibraltar will be organized for Saturday afternoon after lunch.

Attached, you will find a registration form for the meeting and the Rock Hotel. It is an excellent 4* hotel, a wee bit colonial style, with a beautiful view on the strait, Algeciras, and Morocco if the weather is clear. Can you please return the included registration form **before the 18th of March at the very latest** at yvesguisan@sapphirenet.gi? It looks rather early, but is absolutely necessary for organization purposes.

Usually, the weather is extremely pleasant in May in Gibraltar. You have to expect temperatures between 24°C and 28°C. Beside our always interesting and fraternal working sessions, we should enjoy a very good time in Gibraltar.
